

Test on Adria International Raceway with Lamborghini factory team

Just one week after his first test in the Lamborghini Huracan Super Trofeo car, Thomas Krebs was invited to do another test together with the Lamborghini factory team in Italy. The test was driven on October 28 at Adria International Raceway, located about one hour from Bologna.

Under extremely wet conditions, Thomas could perform some fast and consistent laps, getting more experience with the car and the different driving styles. He made a good impression to the chief engineer for Lamborghini as well as the Super Trofeo series coordinator, who both followed Thomas closely during the test.



The following day Thomas was invited to a meeting with the chief for Lamborghini's motorsport department, Giorgio Sanna, including a tour around the Lamborghini factory and production in Sant'Agata Bolognese. In the meeting some of the opportunities within Lamborghini's Young Driver Program was discussed, as well as possibilities and requirements to become a GT3 factory driver in the future. Lamborghini is very interested in young talented drivers, who can become a part of Lamborghini and represent the brand as ambassadors.
